

E-safety pupil survey

Over the half term we looked at the pupil E-safety survey. The key findings were that the majority of pupils had access to Ipads, PCs and Laptops. A high number of Year 2 pupils either had their own mobile phones or access to their parents phones. It was reassuring that the majority of pupils mainly used IT to play games and didn't really know many YouTubers, however 'Mr Beast' was mentioned several times. The majority of pupils didn't know how to download apps or were not allowed to without their parents/carers. The majority of KS1 pupils were able to take photos with their devices but not necessarily send them onto others. The main point that stood out was that the majority of pupils were allowed to use their devices in their bedroom. We asked the children what they would do if something bad happens when they are online or you are not sure about something and the majority said that they would tell a parent or grown up or turn the device off. With this information we will continue to reinforce our IT online safety rules and encourage all pupils to speak to a trusted adult when something doesn't feel right. Please continue to support your children and monitor them closely when using IT, especially when they are online.
