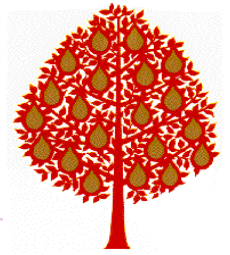

Dear Parents and Carers

The children have been extremely busy in class this week learning all about their new topics. We have also been talking about our Core Value of Honesty and what it means to be honest and dishonest. It is extremely reassuring that the majority of our young children understand this important life skill and are honest in and around school.

As a school we are also looking at how we can keep safe in school, especially when moving around. We have all been learning how to do "The Perryfield Walk", which means we walk with our hands by our side (not in pockets or behind our backs) so if we fall over we can break the fall with our hands. The whole school emphasis on "The Perryfields Walk" has had a positive impact this week with children walking in school, not running and less accidents!

Reminders.....

TOYS - Please can I remind parents of the school rule that children should not be bringing any toys into school from home. Toys are getting shared, lost and broken which is resulting in upset children and lost learning time for all. Please can you check bags and pockets before coming to school. We have lots of equipment and toys in school to use if needed. Thank you for your support with this matter.

COATS— The outside temperature has plummeted and there are lots of children going outside without doing up their coats. Please can we ask all parents/carers to make sure that they are all able to do this themselves and that the coat zips are working. This is a life skill that all the children (4years+) should be able to do independently and staff should not be expected to do these up.

VELCRO SHOES & TRAINERS— Thank you to everyone who is following the school uniform policy. This is to remind everyone that all children should be wearing school shoes (**not boots**) and these must have Velcro fastenings (**not laces**). For PE all trainers should also have Velcro Fastenings (**not laces**). Infant school children are unable to do up laces and for health and safety reasons must not wear these to school. If seen, staff will do these up but they must not be worn in school. This will be monitored
